



- 1. I will respect and take care of the iPad I am using.
- 2. I will not walk around with the iPad.
- 3. I will wash and dry my hands before using the iPad.
- 4. I will keep food and drinks away from the iPad since they may cause damage to the device.
- 5. I will follow adult instructions and stay on task.
- 6. I will only use the app permitted for the specified task.
- 7. I will only use the approved soft cleaning towels to clean the iPad after I use it.
- 8. When my teacher is speaking to the whole class I will sleep the iPad and pay attention.
- 9. Accidental damage is to be reported to the teacher at the time of the incident.
- 10. I will not disassemble any part of the iPad or attempt any repairs.
- 11. I understand that I am responsible for any damage caused by neglect, misuse or abuse.
- 12. I understand that in the case of intentional damage or neglect; I will be required to pay for the repairs or full replacement if the repairs exceed the cost of purchasing a new device.
- 13. I will not use photos, videos and/or audio recordings of myself or and other person in an inappropriate manner.
- 14. I will obey the general school rules concerning behaviour and communication that apply to iPad and computer use.
